

Sewer and Storm Water and Related Issues

1. Ruby's Alley in Hanover Section of Nanticoke, grade alley , fill ruts with stone and survey area for storm water piping and storm inlet estimate prior to paving alley.
2. Clean tops of storm inlets due to heavy debris in Nanticoke, Hanover and Honey Pot section due to flooding
3. Washington and Prospect street- repair 2 storm inlets
